The National Prosthetics Centre (NPC) is a specialised public health facility established to improve access to prosthetic services for people who have lost a limb due to diabetes, trauma, illness or other medical conditions.

Our goal is to provide accessible, quality prosthetic services while supporting patients throughout their journey towards greater mobility and independence.

One of the Centre's key features is its ability to manufacture customised artificial limbs right here in Trinidad and Tobago.

The Centre represents a practical outcome of strengthened cooperation between **Trinidad and Tobago, India and the Jaipur Foot Organisation**, bringing proven prosthetic technology, technical expertise and skills transfer to the public health system.

OUR SERVICES

The National Prosthetic Centre provides:

Custom Prosthetic Limbs – Artificial limbs designed and fitted to meet the individual needs.

Prosthetic Assessment – Professional assessment to determine the appropriate prosthetic solution.

Fitting and Adjustment – Proper fitting and adjustments to promote comfort, function and mobility.

Rehabilitation Support – Assistance to help patients adapt to and use their prosthesis effectively.

Physiotherapy Services - Provides patients with access to rehabilitation and therapeutic support aimed at improving mobility.

Patient Guidance and Support – Information and assistance throughout the prosthetic care process.



WHO CAN ACCESS THE CENTRE?

The National Prosthetic Centre provides services to persons who have lost a limb as a result of:

- Diabetes and related complications
- Trauma or accidents
- Other medical conditions requiring amputation

Each patient receives care based on their individual needs, with a focus on quality, comfort, functionality and rehabilitation.

Citizens of Trinidad and Tobago can access services for free. Non-Nationals can access by paying a service fee of USD \$2000.00

HOW TO GET AN APPOINTMENT

Getting started is simple.

Step 1 Get a Referral

A signed referral from a medical institution or provider is required to access prosthetic services.

Step 2 Submit Your Referral

Email your referral to npc@health.gov.tt.

Step 3 Virtual Assessment

The Centre will contact you to arrange a virtual assessment.

Step 4 Receive Your Appointment

Once the referral is received, the Centre will assist with scheduling an appointment and providing information on the next steps.

NEXT STEPS AND TIMELINE

ATTEND YOUR IN-PERSON EVALUATION - Visit the Centre for an on-site assessment to determine your prosthetic needs.

YOUR LIMB IS FABRICATED - Your customised prosthetic limb is manufactured at the National Prosthetics Centre.

FITTING & ADJUSTMENTS - Return to the Centre for fitting and any necessary adjustments to ensure your prosthesis is comfortable and functional. The process takes a maximum of 48hrs.

FULL PAYMENT - Payment can be made via wire transfer or online transfer. NO CASH DEPOSITS will be facilitated. The Centre will advise you of the banking information.
